The Wabash Valley Chapters of ASM (American Society for Metals), ASQ (American Society for Quality), and SME (Society of Manufacturing Engineers), herewith announce the establishment of a joint scholarship program for high school student Regional Science Fair participants with intent to attend a College in West-Central Indiana (DePauw University, Indiana State University, IVY Tech State College, Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology, St. Mary of the Woods College, Vincennes University). This year's Regional Science Fair is scheduled to be held at DePauw University on Saturday, March 13<sup>th</sup>, 2004.

One \$500 scholarship recipient will be selected by a panel of three judges from the sponsoring organizations, with the possibility of allocating up to an additional \$ 500 to be shared by one or two runner up winners. The winner(s) will be chosen by the judges from among the entrees with relevance to the interests of the sponsoring organizations. The funds will be deposited with the local school of choice of the winner(s), for the exclusive use of that student in connection with educational expenses.
